WEDNESDAY CLASS

- 4th March Drawing session. Bring some vegetables to set up a still life for yourself. Draw in pencil or pen
- 11th March Drawing session. Drawing a portrait from life. Charcoal
- 18th March Quick 5 minute drawings of each other. Sketch book, own choice of media
- 25th March Large group picture in acrylic. Acrylics.
- 1st April Landscape collage. Reference picture, colour magazines, pritt stick, paper.
- 8th April Easter card design. Lino cut materials, smooth paper.
- 22nd April Paper mache 3D sculpture of bird/animal. Newspapers, wall paper paste, or flour and water paste. wire ,pliers, bowl to put paste in. Reference photo.
- 29th April Painting sculpture in acrylics.
- 6th May Abstract based on flowers. Acrylics or own choice of media.
- 13th May Copy of a famous artist's work. Own choice of artist and media.
- 20th May Outside sketching of houses or church in Youlgrave....Sketch book, warm clothes, stool. If wet inside....botanical painting
- 27th May Outside painting the river Bradford. Water colours or pastels. Stool, warm clothes If wet inside botanical painting.

THURSDAY CLASS

- 5th March Drawing session. Bring vegetables to set up a still life. Charcoal or ink
- 12th March Drawing session. Self portrait.. mirror on a stand ,charcoal, cartridge paper
- 19th March Glass ware. .dry pastels, pastel paper or sugar paper.
- 26th March Spring time scene...Good reference photo, dry pastels and pastel paper.
- 2nd April Steps....Good reference photo of steps. Pencil and sketch book
- 9th April Easter eggs. Miniature painting on blown egg shells. Water colour. Egg box.
- 23rd April Townscape. Good reference photo, ink and water colour.
- 30th April Large animal portrait. Good reference photo, own choice of media.
- 7th May Flowers in a vase. Using a resist -masking fluid/white candle/oil pastels and water colours.
- 14th May Paintings of water...waves/or waterfalls/sea/ lakes/ reflections/ good reference photos, acrylics
- 21st May Sketching outside, buildings in Youlgrave or church.. watercolours and ink, stool, warm clothes
- 28th May Painting outside, River Bradford. watercolours, stool, warm clothes
